At our December Board meeting, our Board members voted to support the LOW Lions/LOWA initiative to build a new pavilion structure at Hollyfield Park. The Lioness Lions board approved the purchase of 10 tables with benches at a cost of approximately \$6,500. This is a lasting structure our local community will be able to enjoy for many years.

Don't forget our Book Sale will reopen on Saturday, February 29th. Come by and check out the shelves and replenish your reading collection.

We've all been concerned about the historic level of bush fires in Australia. Fires have ravaged more than 25 million acres, taking lives, destroying homes and impacting wildlife, leaving behind devastated families and communities. Since November 2019, Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) has been awarding grant requests for funds during this time of need. LCIF has awarded US\$143,000 in grant funds. This funding purchased water tanks in District 201-N2 and provided immediate assistance to those affected in Districts 201-N1, 201-N2, 201-V3, and 201-V6. Additional LCIF grants are expected to be awarded in the coming weeks. You can donate to LCIF to help respond to Australia at www.lionsclubs.org.

On March 21st, we will host the Spring Craft Show/Flea Market. Set up is on the evening of the 20th.
