#### Dues for 2017-2018

By unanimous ballot vote of attending members at our June 8<sup>th</sup> dinner meeting, it was decided we would transition from the Lake of the Woods Lioness Club to the Lake of the Woods Lioness Lions Club. Although this will provide us several benefits to continue to make a real difference in our community, it will also result in an increase of dues in the amount of \$80.00 per member/per year.
