#### THE INSIDER'S VIEW

Minutes from the August 26, 2021 BOD Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm on Thursday, August 26, 2021, by President Kathy Merritt. The following board members were present: President Kathy Merritt, Secretary Gina Davies, Treasurers Loretta LaTerra and Diane Pittman, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Gail Hardin and 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President Darcy Jennings, Tamers Ann Wood and Rani Manhard, Membership Director Donalda Lovelace, Director Arlene Rich and Immediate Past President Jayne Owiesny.

### SECRETARY'S REPORT: Gina Davies

- The minutes of the July 22, 2021 BOD meeting, which were previously distributed were approved. Motion made by Arlene Rich and seconded by Jayne Owiesny. Motion passed. A discussion about publishing minutes (in the LOWDOWN) before they have been approved by our Lioness BOD (usually at the following meeting which is after LOWDOWN is published) ensued. It was decided that the minutes would be sent to the entire BOD rather than just to the President for approval/corrections before sending it along to Emily Florence.
- Committee Chairpersons monthly reports: We had a pretty good response from Chairs about the hours that their committees spent on Lioness business. We will be doing this accounting each month.
- 551 people served; \$10,275 plus 35 boxes of school supplies collected and donated to the Food Pantry, OC schools and other community projects; 809 volunteer hours; 169 Lioness Lions involved

- Consideration of an Opt-in for dinner reservations rather than the Opt-out:
   discussion followed, and it was decided that Opt-out is the best way to handle dinner reservations. Opt-in would mean more e-mail communication for
  the Tamers, and it would put added responsibility on each member who is
  planning to attend the meeting. Opt-out allows the few members who can't
  attend the meeting enough time to make that known to the Tamers.

### PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Kathy Merritt

LOWDOWN items - shredding; thank yous: Kathy brought to our attention
that there were a few questions about what goes into the LOWDOWN.
Since this is our newsletter, Kathy and the board felt that Thank Yous and
community-wide collection dates that help the Food Pantry should be part
of the LOWDOWN. If there are any questions about whether something
should be put in, Kathy is the one to contact and she will make the decision
and/or check with some BOD members for their opinions.

- Card Party update we have 50-60 reservations right now; an ad will be in the Lake Currents this week; flyers will be put in the Clubhouse; different card games need different-sized tables and therefore different reservations; this will be communicated to the reservation chairperson. Since Orange County is in the substantial risk category for the virus, LOW Lioness Lions BOD feels that each attendee who is not vaccinated should be asked to wear a mask at this event. This is in accordance with the suggestions of the Governor and the CDC. Also, if anyone should feel sick or experience any virus symptoms on the day of the event, they should not attend. Event money will be refunded if anyone becomes ill and can't attend. These decisions were made to keep the Card Party/Fashion Show safe and successful. A separate note will be sent to each Lioness Lion from Kathy.
