# **KOREAN CHEESY CORN**

(as seen in the Washington Post)

During the pandemic, many media outlets printed recipes people could try at home. At the end of the year, the Washington Post printed their top 100 and said if you were going to cook only one, make it #4, Korean Cheesy Corn. It's the only recipe I tried but I've made it three times, and I rarely cook.

Preheat oven to 400.

Lightly oil oven proof skillet.

In a large bowl, combine the following:

4 ears of fresh shucked corn, cut off the cob.

½ cup mayo,

2 tsp Siracha Sauce

1 1/2 tsp sugar

4 oz. shredded mozzarella

Add kosher salt and pepper to taste.

Spread mixture into skillet.

Sprinkle with 4 oz. mozzarella and some chopped green onions.

Cook for 15 minutes. May broil to brown top.

Serve as a side dish or as an appetizer with pita or other sturdy chip.


