The table, at the cost of \$50 has been secured. We need to have a presence at the market. Any VINTAGE Christmas items may also be sold. What happened? It seems that many of the vendors who participate in the event did not appreciate that we offered used items at great prices.

Carolyn met with Heidi, Kathy Merritt and Barbara Tomayko. They were offered an alternative date, at no cost to the Lionesses along with free advertising for "our" event. However, the date offered is the Saturday after Thanksgiving. That presented a number of problems for us because it is a difficult time to get volunteers and did not allow us enough time to set up our own event. **The board decided not to do our sale on that date.**

Nicki Buell presented an alternative plan. It is going to be called **Christmas Treasures, Gifts, Jewelry and Bake Sale.** We will be offering our Christmas items and other items on December 7th, the date of the Christkindlemarkt, BUT at a **different location**. We will be setting up right outside the Ferris Building, where we have the book sales. Tents and tables will be set up. Our Christmas Treasures, Gifts, Jewelry and Bake Sale event will run alongside of the Lions usual Saturday Yard Sale from 9-1.

One problem is that we desperately need a committee or individual to organize this event. This will involve coordinating the gathering of Christmas items. Finding a garage to store the items. 
