We have so many people to thank for our wonderful Shimmery Shamrock Gala:

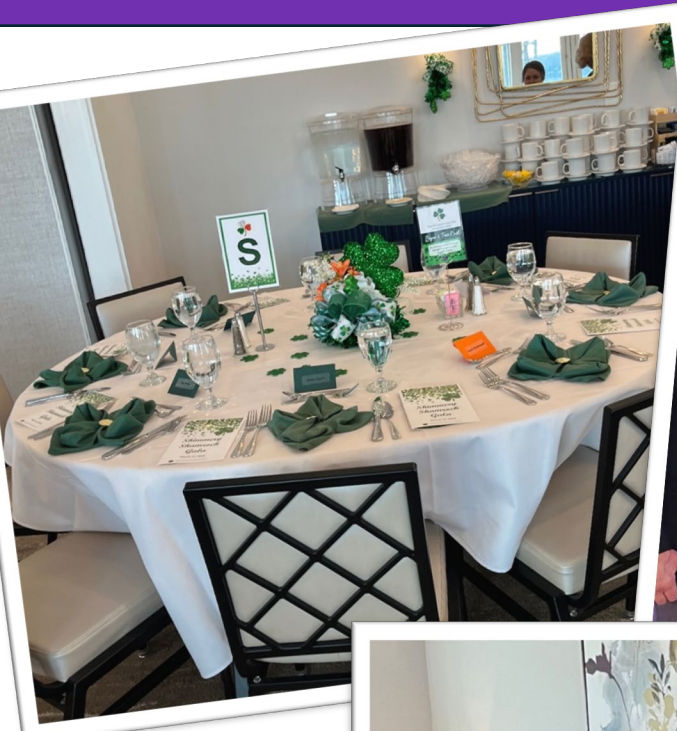
- ♣ **The wonderful people** that bought tickets and came to the gala and spent their hard earned money supporting our fundraising efforts in the community!
